The purpose of the cross-country stage check is to determine your ability to navigate as Pilot-In-Command to airports beyond the local area. Pilotage, D.R., and electronic methods will be evaluated in addition to your aeronautical decision-making skills.

Documentation:

- Photo ID Student Pilot Certificate Medical Certificate TSA approval as necessary
- Logbook entries per 61.93(e)

Stage Check Instructor will evaluate the following as Satisfactory (S) or Needs Improvement (N).

_____ Aeronautical charts for VFR using pilotage and dead reckoning with the aid of a magnetic compass.

_____ Aircraft performance charts for cross country flight planning.

_____ Destination airport information, runways, TPA, services, hours of operation, chart supplement guide.

_____ Weather reports and forecasts, go/no-go decision.

_____ NOTAMS and TFR's.

_____ ATC flight following and FSS services while enroute.

_____ VOR navigation, course interception, tracking a radial.

_____ GPS navigation, FPL, NRST, Direct, WPT.

_____ Emergency procedures including lost comm. and equipment malfunctions.

_____ Diversion to nearest airport.

_____ Lost Procedures.

_____ Fuel management and estimate remaining fuel.

_____ Traffic pattern procedures including departure, arrival, entry, and approach.

_____ Collision avoidance, wake turbulence precautions, windshear avoidance.

_____ Hazardous terrain recognition, avoidance, operational restrictions for the area.

_____ Class B, C, D airspace requirements.

_____ Power settings and mixture control.
